





- 18 december 2018: draft report of the rapporteur:
 - > supports the harmonisation of the control rules among Member States;
 - ➤ proposes several complementary elements, such as a designation of a unique administrative body in each Member State to coordinate the implementation of fisheries control, and a unique electronic inspection form across the EU.
 - As regards the necessary simplification of the control system, proposes measures to make it more accessible, among which a simple tool developed by the EFCA that would allow fishermen to have real-time access to the rules concerning them, and unique declaration forms in all Member States.



Fisheries control revision



- > opposes the limited introduction of a closed-circuit television (CCTV) on fishing vessels for surveillance of conforming to the landing obligation.
- ➤ Other amendments bring new elements on control rules for aquaculture and recreational fisheries.

Just to know...

- ❖ 18 june 2018: preliminary exchange on the new EMFF by the Agriculture and Fisheries Council EP Committee on Fisheries (PECH):
- ❖ 20 June 2018: public hearing on the issues and challenges encountered during the current EMFF and how to avoid them while implementing the new EMFF. First exchange of views on the newly proposed EMFF.
- 29 August 2018: second exchange of views.
- ❖ 4 September 2018: Draft report of the rapporteur → proposes to keep the same level of funding as the current EMFF and proposes to allow explicitly all measures supporting the four priorities that do not belong to the list of ineligible operations. Some other proposed modifications concern permanent and temporary cessation (seen as too prescriptive and rigid in the Commission proposal), the outermost regions (e.g. to allow support for the renewal of the traditional fleets), the processing and marketing of fishery and aquaculture products (e.g. to continue certain common rules) and support for producer organisation (e.g. the continuation of support for temporary storage).

945 amendments have been submitted, which have been considered in the PECH committee meeting of 27 November 2018.

The committee vote is scheduled for the meeting of 19 February 2019.???


4 november 2018: opinion of the BUDG committee propose to reinforce the EMFF in accordance with its new mission on the blue economy. Concretely, the Parliament is proposing an increase of 10% as compared to the current EMFF (in 2018 prices, excluding the UK). In terms of current prices, this translates into a budget of €7 739 million for 2021-2027, an increase of 26% as compared to the Commission proposal.



Oggetto: Piano di Gestione Rigetti per la specie vongola (*Chamelea gallina*) redatto ai sensi del Regolamento (UE) N.1380/2013 - Regolamento delegato (UE) 2016/2376 della Commissione del 13 ottobre 2016 che istituisce un piano di rigetto per i molluschi bivalvi *Venus spp.* nelle acque territoriali italiane - Decreto Ministeriale 27 dicembre 2016. Adozione del Piano di Gestione Nazionale Rigetti, per la risorsa vongola (*Chamelea gallina*). Richiesta di proroga.

Come è noto con il Regolamento delegato (UE) 2016/2376 della Commissione del 13 ottobre 2016 che istituisce un piano di rigetto per i molluschi bivalvi *Venus spp.* nelle acque territoriali italiane è stata consentita, previa l'adozione da parte di questa Amministrazione di un appropriato Piano di gestione, la riduzione della taglia minima di riferimento per la conservazione di tale specie fissandola a una lunghezza totale di 22 mm.

Ciò premesso, con riferimento alla pertinente normativa Comunitaria ed, in particolare, ai sensi dell'articolo 15 del Regelamento (UE) 1380/2013 relativo all'obbligo di sbarco, i Consigli Consultivi, tra cui il MEDAC, hanno visto confermare e rafforzare il proprio ruolo e costituiscono, allo stato, gli unici organismi di confronto con gli stakeholders a livello europeo.

Alla luce della proficua collaborazione del MEDAC già dimostrata nella redazione del Piano di Gestione Nazionale Rigetti per la risorsa vongola (*Chamelea gallina*), si chiede di collaborare con questa Amministrazione al fine di fornire gli elementi necessari per la redazione di un aggiornato e compiuto Piano di Gestione, da sottoporre ai pertinenti Uffici della Commissione Europea per la richiesta di un proseguimento di tale Piano. Nel quadro normativo di riferimento il contributo del MEDAC potrà confermare ancora una volta il proprio valido supporto con l'azione della proposta che questa Amministrazione intende presentare alla Commissione nelle prossime settimane.

Legal basis

Regulation (EC) 1967/06 (Mediterranean Regulation)

Article 15a

Procedure for establishing minimum conservation reference sizes in the context of discard plans

The Commission shall be empowered, for the purpose of adopting the acts referred to in Article 15(6) of Regulation (EU) No 1380/2013 and for the duration thereof, to establish minimum conservation reference sizes for species subject to the landing obligation set out in Article 15 of that Regulation. Such sizes shall be established by means of a delegated act adopted in accordance with Article 29a of this Regulation and Article 18 of Regulation (EU) No 1380/2013, with the aim of ensuring the protection of juveniles of marine organisms, and may derogate, where appropriate, from the minimum conservation reference sizes specified in Annex III to this Regulation.
