Invitation to attend the scientific and technical seminar on small pelagic fisheries in the Adriatic Sea

Dear Mr Buonfiglio,

As already anticipated¹, I have the pleasure to invite you to participate in the scientific and technical seminar on small pelagic fisheries in the Adriatic Sea.

Several difficulties have been experienced in recent months to perform reliable stock assessments and to provide scientific advice on MSY ranges and related conservation reference points for the stocks of sardine and anchovy in the region. Moreover, parallel processes are ongoing at the level of different scientific bodies (STECF, GFCM-SAC) and information is sometimes fragmented.

We believe it is necessary to have a discussion on those issues, with a view to ensuring that all those who have been part or who will be part of the forthcoming work on stock assessment may have an opportunity to share information, data and methodologies.

I would like to stress the importance of this topic for the Commission. In light of the worrying situation of most Mediterranean stocks², the preparation of Commission proposals for EU multiannual plans in the Mediterranean Sea is a priority for our Commissioner. This is reflected by the actions carried out in the last year, notably for the preparation of a multiannual plan for the management of small pelagic stocks in the North Adriatic Sea. MEDAC has also played an important role of consultation and has
