



MEDAC is made up of 42 members representing the fisheries sector and other interest groups (such as NGOs and recreational fishery associations) coming from 8 EU Member States





RESEARCH

- To intensify research activities and the evaluation of the state of stocks, extending to recreational fisheries too
- To evaluate the state of the fishery resources concentrating on the main target species only
- To study the other sources of impact, other than fisheries activities, which could affect the state of the fishery resources



CONTROL

- Monitoring and control activities to combat illegal fisheries all around the basin
- Adopting a more proactive approach in the supply chain (such as distribution, markets and catering)

SPATIAL PLANNING Blue Economy

Regulating access to FRAs and MPAs

Effective system of control, monitoring and management of FRAs and MPAs




TIME FACTOR

SOCIO-ECONOMIC ASPETCS FROM 2008 TO 2014

- NEGATIVE TREND IN EMPLOYMENT -8% AND IN THE NUMBER OF VESSELS – 14%
- SMALL-SCALE FISHERIES DECREASE IN EMPLOYMENT
 -13% AND IN THE NUMBER OF VESSELS -16%



IT IS IMPORTANT TO PUT IN PLACE MEASURES TO SUPPORT FISHING ENTERPRISES AND WORKERS IN THE FUTURE MAPS
